- (4) To vote for a person whose name is not printed on this ballot write or stamp his or her name on a blank "Write-In" area under the names of the candidates. **Do not** write in the name of a person whose name is not printed on this ballot.
- (5) Any other name or symbol or any number other than the number of the ballot printed on this ballot will void the entire ballot.
- (6) The order of the candidates is as printed on this ballot. If you select a greater number of candidates than there are vacancies to be filled, your ballot will be void for legal public order or party purposes or purposes.

- (7) If you show evidence of fraud, or wrongfully mark this ballot, return it and obtain another. Do not attempt to correct mistakes on the ballot by making marks or crosses such as "X" marks or crosses that may void the entire ballot. Prior to tabulating your ballot if you make a mistake in completing the ballot or wish to change your ballot choice, you may obtain and complete a new ballot. You have a right to a replacement ballot upon return of the ballot.
- (8) After completing your ballot, insert it into the ballot container and seal for the election and your ballot has been successfully returned. If no such notice appears, void the assistance of an election inspector.
