- (6) Do not envelope. If you select a greater number of candidates than there are vacancies to be filled, your ticket will be void for that public office or party position or proposal.

- (7) If you have or believe or suspect you have a disability, you are eligible to request assistance on the ballot by making requests
- at a voting location or request assistance at the place of residence or place of assembly in your ballot. You have a right to a replacement ballot upon return of the

- original ballot. After completing your ballot, insert it into the ballot envelope and seal for the ballot that your ballot has been successfully inserted. (It is not valid unless
- inserted, sealed the seal of the election inspector.
