The meeting was called to order at 6:36 p.m. by Mr. Schler.

Public Announcements: Kurt Brewer and Richard Underwood have resigned from the board effective immediately. This leaves membership at 8 currently.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved with a motion by Dr. Papperman, seconded by Ms. Shelby Fisher, and carried.

Subcommittee Reports: Mental Health: The Mental Health subcommittee is in need of new members. The ICM position is still vacant for children. The Mental Health Program Director position is still vacant – internal candidate interviews have been completed. The next meeting will be held on 12/11 at 4:30 p.m.

OPWDD: The DDSO system has to pay back \$10 billion to OIG. The People First Waiver was not approved. There is currently not any overnight respite provided by the ARC – the DDSO provides 1 bed that is always utilized. Ms. Fisher nominates Ms. Shelby Fisher to be the new chairperson; Ms. Amidon seconds, and carried. The next meeting will be held on 12/11 at 5:30 p.m.

ASA: Updates were given by all providers. Vivotrol will be added as a treatment drug. There is currently 1 staff vacancy at SCATP. Hand sanitizer abuse is becoming prevalent amongst teens. The Substance Abuse Coalition is looking for input for their Follies. The next meeting will be held on 12/18 at 5:30 p.m.

Committee Reports: None.

Administrative Remarks:

1. **Mental Health Clinic Units** of Service for **July 2012** were 1,196, which represents an 11% increase from July of 2011's units.
2. **Mental Health Clinic Units** of Service for **August 2012** were 1,164, which represents a 7% decrease from August of 2011's units
3. **Addictions Clinic Units** of Service for **July 2012** were 470, which represents a 50% increase from the number of units delivered in July 2011.
4. **Addictions Clinic Units** of Service for **August 2012** were 516, which represents a 33% increase from the number of units delivered in August 2011.
5. **Mental Health Clinic Waiting-list** – There is no Waiting list.

6. **COI** – Nothing new to report on this item.
7. **BHO Update:** State DOH, OMH and OASAS have approved extending Phase I of BHO by one year, and will be looking at targeted populations within the inpatient/detox population.
8. **Suzanne Sinclair-** On 8/14/12 the Seneca County Board of Supervisors approved the application for Suzanne Sinclair to a 4 year term on the Seneca County Community Services Board, effective 8/14/12.
9. **Scott Visits NYC LGU** – on 8/23/12 Scott met with the NYC DCS, Adam Karpati, and Trish Marsik, Deputy DCS, along with several members of the CLMHD Executive Committee for a day long review of their programs and initiatives. He returned with a lot of good ideas for Seneca County, and was even asked to share the write up for our 2013 Peer Employee Program with their staff.
10. **Future Format for Administrative Remarks:** Starting with the October CSB meeting's administrative remarks and for all subsequent CSB & CSB committee meetings' agendas, updates on the progress made against the County Plan Priorities and their respective/related strategies will be mailed out ahead of the meeting in an excel file that can be viewed by each CSB and CSB Committee member prior to the next meeting. This will allow for each board member to see the progress YTD and over time (as the progress will be logged in in timeline fashion) and Scott will simply answer any questions on the progress report (rather than reading it to everyone at the meeting).

Old Business: None.

New Business: Ms. Fisher would like revised acronyms for the CSB manual that she is currently working on revamping.

The board went into executive session at 7:36 p.m. to discuss membership with a motion by Ms. Amidon, seconded by Ms. Roberta Fisher, and carried.
