

Who is eligible for The Seneca County Transportation Initiative Program?

You must be:

- A resident of Seneca County
- 19 years of age or older
- Working at least 30 hours per week
- A parent of a minor child (or pregnant)
- A non-custodial parent of a minor child, paying support

Note: You must have a valid
NYS Driver's License

FEATURES OF THE PROGRAM:

Eligibility/suitability screening for the Affordable Transportation Program (car loan program) at Generations Bank.

Assistance with case management and supportive services while participating in the Affordable Transportation Program.

Budgeting workshops/one-on-one sessions to assist families in improving credit and meeting their financial goals.

Emergency Assistance to working families who qualify under the TANF 200% guidelines, on a case-by-case basis, who may need help with gas costs, repairs, insurance payments, DMV Fees.

What are the steps in obtaining a car loan through the Generations Bank?

1. Fill out the 200% TANF application and return with all requested documentation.
2. Meet with the Seneca County STI Program Counselor for an initial eligibility/suitability screening.
3. Provide all paperwork/documentation requested.
4. Meet with a loan officer at Generations Bank to discuss the loan options and follow through with the loan officer's recommendations.

If approved for a car loan, you will be required to meet with the STI Program Counselor on a monthly basis. You will also be required to attend a Budgeting Skills Workshop. The Program Counselor will assist with budgeting skills, career development and other needs to ensure success in the car loan program as well as success in establishing good credit and an improved financial future.
