## Local Law No. 4 of the year 2007.

A local law repealing Seneca County Local Law No. 2 of the Year 2002

Be it enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the

SECTION 1. It is the determination of the Board of Supervisors that the personnel and other costs of administering the county's security alarm fee program outweigh the slight revenue potential of such program, unduly burden local businesses and may tend to discourage potentially life saving connections to the county's 911 center.

SECTION 2. Seneca County Local Law No. 2 of the Year 2002, entitled "A local law establishing Penalties and Procedures For Security Alarm Devices," is, and shall be, repealed as of the effective date of this local law, except as set forth in Section "3," below.

SECTION 3. Any unpaid fines or other charges previously imposed, or remaining unpaid which have become a lien upon the real property and/or real property tax and included in the county tax bills rendered, and which remain unpaid, shall remain due and owing and shall be collected in the same manner as other taxes and charges against the real property.

SECTION 4. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this Local Law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment, decree or order shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment, decree or order shall have been rendered and the remainder of this Local Law shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
