COUNTY WELCOMES LAGO RESORT AND CASINO

Seneca County Applauds New Casino Siting;
Eagerly Anticipates Lago and Needed Jobs it Brings to Region

New York State today recommended approval for the Lago Resort and Casino Project to move ahead in the Town of Tyre in Seneca County. Since it was first proposed, the Seneca County Board of Supervisors has unanimously voted to support this project and have actively advocated for its approval.

“This is a great victory for the taxpayers and residents of the Town of Tyre and Seneca County,” said Tyre Town Supervisor Ron McGreevy. “The Town of Tyre has been eagerly waiting for this news and for the jobs this project will deliver for our community. We have worked tirelessly to properly review this project and are now eager to see Lago Resort and Casino become a reality.”

“Today is a great day for Seneca County,” said Chairman of the Seneca County Board of Supervisors Bob Hayssen. “Area residents can now look forward to the much needed jobs this project will bring. I have been proud to lead the fight in this effort with Supervisor McGreevy and our colleagues on the Board of Supervisors. I want to thank Governor Cuomo for his leadership in making today’s announcement a reality for Seneca County and New York State.”

In total, the Lago Resort and Casino will provide 1,800 construction jobs and 1,800 (direct and indirect) permanent jobs. As part of the project proposal, Seneca County residents will have preferential status for hiring.
