IMPROPER COOLING AND REFRIGERATED STORAGE OF POTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS FOODS.

ITEM # 5A WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S). CRITICAL VIOLATION

Part or parts of the violation item were observed to be in violation which were corrected at the time of inspection.

Code Requirements

Potentially hazardous foods are not kept at or below 45oF during cold holding, except smoked fish not kept at or below 38oF during cold holding.

Inspector Findings

Chicken found in cooler at 51F. Corrected, voluntarily discarded. Sausage found in cooler at 54F. Corrected, voluntarilly discarded.

ITEM # 5B WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S). CRITICAL VIOLATION

Part or parts of the violation item were observed to be in violation which were corrected at the time of inspection.

Code Requirements

Potentially hazardous foods are not cooled by an approved method where the food temperature can be reduced from 120oF to 70oF or less within two hours and 70oF to 45oF within four hours.

Inspector Findings

Macaroni and Cheese found at 61F in walk in cooler. Macaroni and Cheese was prepared at 9:00am, was found at 61F at 4:05pm. Item failed to reach 45F within the allotted time frame.

IMPROPER HOT HOLDING OF POTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS FOODS.

ITEM # 6A WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S). CRITICAL VIOLATION

Part or parts of the violation item were observed to be in violation which were corrected at the time of inspection.

Code Requirements

Potentially hazardous foods are not kept at or above 140oF during hot holding.

Inspector Findings

4 Items found out of temperature on steam table during hot holding. Chicken Parmesan was found 121F-134F, Macaroni and Cheese was found 120F-128F, Spaghetti was found at 118F, Ziti was found 130F. Corrected, Voluntarily discarded.
