RESOLUTIONS AND MOTIONS

WAIVE LOCAL LAW REQUIREMENTS FOR EMPIRE FARM DAYS

RESOLUTION NO. 169-14, moved by Mr. Davidson, second by Mr. Reynolds and adopted.

WHEREAS, the sponsors of Empire Farm Days have requested from the Board of Supervisors a waiver of the provisions of Local Law No. 2 of 1979; and

WHEREAS, Local Law No. 2 of 1979 assures traffic safety for mass gatherings; and

WHEREAS, all necessary state permits involving health emergencies, crowd control, and food and health code regulations will be secured before the Empire Farm Days begins; and

WHEREAS, the Government Operations Committee approved this resolution at its meeting on July 22, 2014; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the requirements of Local Law No. 2 of 1979 be and hereby are waived by the Seneca County Board of Supervisors for Empire Farm Days event on August 5, 6 and 7, 2014.
