Site Plan & Use Variance
Park Outdoor Advertising
Intersection 5&20 and 318

The applicant proposes to construct 3 outdoor advertising signs on property at the intersection of Route 318 and Routes 5&20. The face of each sign will be 288 Sq. Ft. (12' X 25'). Two of the signs will be double faced while one will be sign faced. The bottom of each sign is to be 15' above grade.

The applicants wish to list their house for sale as a two-unit residence. The area is not zoned for two units and Town Zoning Records do not show that this was either a pre-existing use or that a Variance had previously been granted. On February 20, 2015, the Town of Waterloo Code Officer issued a permit to Seneca Meadows, Inc. to Construct and Operate the Clay Mine as approved by the Town Board on July 28th, 2014 and the Town Planning Board on August 26th, 2014. The Concerned Citizens of Seneca County contest that the permit was issued inappropriately as the access drive crosses the R-1 Zone, and have filed a petition to the Zoning Board of Appeals for review of this action.

Dog Kennel Regulations

The Town Planning Board has prepared a Town Dog Kennel Law. The Law would require a Town Permit for any Dog Kennel wherein nine or more dogs, over the age of six months, are kept for sale, boarding, breeding, grooming, letting for hire, training or any other purpose involving compensation, whether monetary or otherwise.

It is proposed to construct a Solar array. The property needs a Use Variance, an Area Variance (to be located 6' from property line) and a Special Use Permit. The area to be covered by the solar panels is 9' X 94'. The array will have a 30 degree tilt and include 28 Panels. There will be an Inverter structure located next to the array.
