### IMPROPER HOT HOLDING OF POTENTIALLY HAZARDOUS FOODS.

#### ITEM # 6A WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 4 TIME(S). CRITICAL VIOLATION

Part or parts of the violation item were observed to be in violation which were corrected at the time of inspection.

##### Code Requirements

Potentially hazardous foods are not kept at or above 140oF during hot holding.

##### Inspector Findings

The following items not adhering to approved (1/21/2015) TPHC parameters within the facility. Sausage pizza and Meat pizza found on serving line were not following time on pizza log 10am-2:pm. Pizza found and voluntarily discarded at 2:44pm. 10 Garlic knots found out of approved time per TPHC voluntarily discarded. 3 Chicken, 3Veggie, 3 Pepperoni for out of approved time per TPHC, voluntarily discarded. Meatballs found at 101F held in hot holding in sauce. During the interview with chef Shawn it was found that the meatballs were clocked to proper temperate and have been in hot holding for 45 minuets. Corrected, Rapidly reheated to 165F while inspector was present.

### FOOD NOT PROTECTED IN GENERAL

#### ITEM # 8B WAS FOUND IN VIOLATION 1 TIME(S).

Part or parts of the violation item were observed to be in violation which were corrected at the time of inspection.

##### Code Requirements

In use food dispensing utensils improperly stored

##### Inspector Findings

Ice scoop found under soda fountain spouts. Corrected, sanitized scoop and advised to keep in ice with the handle up.
