The Seneca County Department of Health is pleased to announce its participation in the Clean Water Infrastructure Act of 2017 State Septic System Replacement Fund. Funds for the program were made available to Seneca County through the efforts of Senator Helming's office and total approximately \$225,000.00 for 2018.

Properties served by an onsite waste water treatment system (septic system) that are failing and/or in need of updating which are:

1. within 250 feet of Cayuga or Seneca Lake.
2. single or two family homes.
3. small businesses which produce less than 1,000 gallons per day of waste water.
4. **NOT** a seasonal or secondary home.

are eligible to participate in the program.

The program is a reimbursement model and property owners must pay for the required engineering and site work up front. An application to receive the funding must be filed for review with the Health Department and if approved a reimbursement of up to 50% of the project cost, with a maximum of \$10,000.00 may be awarded.
