SENECA COUNTY APPLIES FOR FY 2013 TACTICAL TEAM TARGETED GRANT

RESOLUTION NO. 185-13 moved by Mr. Reynolds; second by Mr. Churchill and adopted by 647 ayes and 103 not present (Davidson, Lafler).

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Services (DHSES) has published FY2013 Tactical Team Targeted Grant Program Request for Application for up to \$100,000 for innovative Law Enforcement projects that advance Tactical Team capabilities through the adaptation of standards; participate in the DHSES Office for Bombing Prevention's SWAT Capability Analysis Program; encourage and support joint training among law enforcement specialty teams, including bomb squads and explosive detection canine teams; and promotes regional partnerships in the development of tactical team capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the grant provides 100% of the funding for project equipment and associated costs with no local cash match requirement; and

WHEREAS, this resolution was reviewed and approved by the Public Safety Committee on September 24, 2013; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to sign any and all documents necessary to apply for, accept the grant contract, and administer the grant contract for up to \$100,000 in funding through the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services' FY2013 Tactical Team Targeted Grant Program Request for Application, subject to approval of the Seneca County Attorney.
