

William Lyman Eastman
(1842-1902)

William L. Eastman was born April 22, 1842 to Chester and Mary Eastman. He was baptized August 20, 1842, at the Ovid Presbyterian Church. He was a student at the Ovid Academy/Seneca Collegiate Institute and the State Agricultural College at Ovid. He married Augusta Nash on June 7, 1866, at the Ovid Presbyterian Church. His children were John N, and Mary L. The 1894 Business Directory lists him as a breeder of horses. He passed away on November 16, 1902. The Ovid history book described him as “a prominent Town of Ovid farmer, seed grower and dealer in horses.” He is buried in the Ovid Union Cemetery.
