Mitchell Rowe, County Manager \$114,092.00; Margaret L, Clerk to the Board, \$59,377.00; Mark Sinkiewicz, District Attorney, \$200,355.00; Michael Mirras, Public Defender, \$83,939.00; Halle Stevens, Finance Director, \$87,505.00, Frank Sinicropi, County Treasurer, \$37,131.50; Lisa Keshel, Director of Real Property Tax, \$58,870.00; Christina Lotz, County Clerk, \$71,571.00; David Ettman, County Attorney, \$108,130.00; Christopher Wagner, Personnel Officer, \$80,000.00; Tiffany Folk, Commissioner Board of Elections, \$64,306; Carl Same, Commissioner Board of Elections, \$64,306; William Luce, Sheriff, \$84,033.00; Vickie Swinehart, Director Public Health; \$97,793.00; Tracy VanVleck, Commissioner of Human Services, \$87,867.00; Sue Sauvageau, Director Weights & Measures, \$60,396.00; Walter Gable, Historian, \$16,750.00; Samuel Priem, Commissioner Public Works, \$103,442.00.

RESOLUTIONS & MOTIONS

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APPLICATION FOR CREATING HEALTHY SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITIES GRANT
RESOLUTION NO. 18-2020, moved by Sprvr. McGreevy, second by Sprvr. Reynolds and adopted.

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Health has released a RFA for the Creating Healthy Schools and Communities Grant; and

WHEREAS, this is a five year grant in the amount of \$305,000 for each year; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant is to increase opportunities for physical activity and improved nutrition for people across the age span; and

WHEREAS, this will be a collaborative grant application by the Health Department and will include all four school districts, Wayne Finger Lakes BOCES, Office for the Aging, Seneca County Planning, Cornell Cooperative Extension and multiple other organizations; and

WHEREAS, this grant requires no local match; and

WHEREAS, the grant application must be submitted by February 4, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Public Health Committee supports the grant application now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Seneca County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Seneca County Health Department to submit an application for the Creating Healthy Schools and Communities Grant.
