Minutes of the January meeting were reviewed. A correction was made to note that Chief Peenstra under Police reform that he was having a public forum not referendum.

A motion was made to accept the January minutes with that correction by Margaret Morse and second by Jim Tanner the motion was approved.

Reports: Community Service - 2 referrals by the end of March however more are coming in and already have three for April.

Pretrial Release - 33 released so far with 57 on pretrial release as of this date.

Ignition Interlock - 17 people sentenced so far this year.

EHM – 7 people on as of this date.

Police Reform - All agencies reported that the plans have been submitted to the State and received.

By Laws – Presentation to the Board of Supervisors. The plan was submitted and approved by the Board. There was only one public person who stated they felt the board was too big and needed be smaller. Dave Ettman explained that the board was made up of members required by the State.

Community Service Annual Service Plan - The State approved an abbreviated version of the service plan without any need for Advisory Board approval. It just needs to be signed off by the County manager.

Margaret reported that she and Undersheriff Cleere are revisiting the idea of treatment court so that it encompasses mental health and drug court.

Margaret also reported that the State expanded MAP and they will be getting more IPADS for Seneca Falls PD and they are bringing Waterloo PD on board.

Kaitlyn is working with Jason Paladino to get the Advisory Board website up and going.
