2021 First quarter continued with 20% withhold from our non-housing programs. If NY gets 15 billion as requested in Federal Stimulus, we could get the 20% withhold back. 5% ongoing reductions to state was in the Governor's budget.

Tammy Orlopp – As a result of Telehealth, the clinic has improved show rates, sessions may be shorter, but are more frequent. Caseloads have also gone up.

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School staff – Schools are doing more family type work.

Old Business – Undersheriff Cleere was not able to attend to update us on the Police Reform Initiative. His comprehensive report was sent to everyone for review. It was reported that the Local PD's have their reform plans on their websites.

New Business – Margaret Morse – the Seneca County Local Plans for all subcommittees are due by June 1st. These will be sent out in the next couple of weeks for everyone to review.
