- HOW TO RETURN ABSENTEE/SPECIAL VOTER BALLOT

- Inclose the sealed envelope bearing the statement in the envelope addressed to the Board of Elections and mail promptly.
- The ballot of the absentee/special voter must be postmarked by the day of the election and received by the Board of Elections not later than 7 days following the day of the election to be cast and counted.
- HOW TO RETURN MILITARY BALLOT

  1. After marking the ballot, fold such ballot and enclose it in the envelope bearing the voter's statement, and seal the envelope.
- 2. Fill in properly the blanks in the statement and sign your name.
- 2. Fill in properly rise claims in the statement and sign your name.
  3. Enclose the sealed envelope bearing the Statement in the envelope addressed to the Board of Elections and mall promptly.
  4. The ballot of the military voter must be postmarked by the day of the election and received by the Board of Elections not later than 13 days following the day of the election to be cast and counted.
