Person Centered Services – PCS is doing a transition services and virtual expo. This is offered on three different dates.

The 2023 Plan was reviewed . Front Door monitoring has been an issue. This is more about how difficult it is to get services. Not believed that the Front Door model is the problem, this is more about those who have fallen through the cracks and eligibility. The information that is should be reported is the number deemed ineligible and why, where those people were referred and what happens to those people. OPWDD is still unable to give this information. This should be left on the 2023 plan and keep pushing to try and get this information. It is uncertain why people fall through the cracks or if OPWDD will expand their criteria. It should still be monitored and explored.

The law enforcement – There is continued training of law enforcement in this area. Kaitlyn Laskoski is doing a great job with Undersheriff Cleere. It is still important to collect these numbers and what the impact is. Number 7 of the plan is will be worded differently. Margaret will report out on progress of CLMHD pilot study. Margaret will update to reflect the 2023 plan and Denise Vreeland will enter the progress from Moziac and PCS. Margaret will send out both plans, one with all the updated progress and the updated plan.

The updated plan can be discussed and possibly voted on via email. The 2023 plan is due in July of 2022.

The progress on the 2022 plan was completed.
