## **Connecting Young Adults to Careers**

**Eligibility:**

**Ages 14-24**

**AND**

**Currently Receiving:**

**Public Assistance, SNAP, HEAP, Medicaid,  
OR,**

**Eligible to receive Public Assistance w/ Household  
Income under the 200% Federal Poverty Guidelines.**

**Documents needed:**

**Birth Certificate**

**Social Security Card**

**Proof of Seneca County Residency**

**Photo ID if over age 18**

**Selective Service if Male over age 18**

**Working Papers if under age 18**

**Work Papers through School  
Guidance Office**

**\*\* If the youth does not have the necessary  
documents the program can help with locating\*\***

The CYAC Program is designed to support youth in the development and improvement of their soft skills such as communication, professionalism, teamwork and critical thinking. Through the skill building process youth can be offered a position in a paid work experience to further support their independence and direction towards future life goals.
