**A RESOLUTION TO INTRODUCE PROPOSED LOCAL LAW H OF 2022, ENTITLED "A LOCAL LAW TO ESTABLISH THE VOTING POWER OF EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF SENECA COUNTY" AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC HEARING**

WHEREAS, the voting power of each of the members of the Seneca County Board of Supervisors is determined by the proportionate population of each of the Towns comprising Seneca County; and

WHEREAS, an adjustment to the weighted vote calculation is required and necessary subsequent to the 2020 Census; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution has been reviewed and approved by the Government Operations Standing Committee at its Meeting on November 8, 2022; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that Local Law H of 2022 entitled "A Local Law to Establish the Voting Power of Each Member of the Board of Supervisors of Seneca County" be and the same is hereby introduced before the Board of Supervisors of Seneca County, New York to read in substantially the following form:

Section 1. In all voting by the Seneca County Board of Supervisors the following weights shall apply to the vote of the members representing the following Towns:

Covert 50	Seneca Falls 70
Fayette 85	Seneca Falls 70
Junius 32	Tyre 24
Lodi 35	Varick 39
Ovid 54	Waterloo 57
Romulus 50	Waterloo 57
Seneca Falls 70	Waterloo 57
	<b>Total: 750</b>

Section 2. Local Law No. 2 of 2012 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Effective date: This local law shall become effective in accordance with the New York State General Municipal and Home Rule Laws; and be it further

RESOLVED, that copies of the aforesaid proposed Local Law be laid upon the desks of each member of the County Board; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Board hold a Public Hearing on said proposed Local Law at the County Office Building, 1 DiPronio Drive, Waterloo New York at or about 6:00 P.M., on December 14, 2022; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Clerk to the Board publish or cause to be published a notice of said Public Hearing in the official newspapers of the County at least ten (10) days prior thereto.
